Goals & Actions
2015-2017**

Goal 1: Support and improve student learning and achievement.

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| 1.1 | Provide academic support for students at Bradley PDS sites, especially one-on-one and small group tutoring, mentoring, and assistance. |
| 1.2 | Provide academic support for ELL students, particularly at St. Mark, Harrison, Glen Oak, and Valeska Hinton, through ETE 235. |
| 1.3 | Work with Bradley PDS teachers and principals to provide enrichment experiences for students. |
| 1.4 | Work with Bradley PDS teachers and principals to provide instructional resources, materials, and supplies. |

Goal 2: Prepare aspiring professionals in education and health sciences.

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| 2.1 | Continue placing substantial numbers of teacher education pre-professionals at Bradley PDS sites for clinical experiences (ETE 116, ETE 211, novice teaching, and student teaching). |
| 2.2 | Make teacher education more interactive with Bradley PDS sites through application- and inquiry- based projects and assignments. |
| 2.3 | Continue strengthening and expanding course connections in nursing, PT, FCS, and EHC with Bradley PDS sites. |
| 2.4 | Provide short-term professional development opportunities for Bradley pre-professionals. |

Goal 3: Provide lifelong learning experiences and leadership opportunities.

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| 3.1 | Develop and maintain strong relationships with cooperating teachers from Bradley PDS sites. |
| 3.2 | Provide opportunities for teachers from Bradley PDS sites to speak and/or provide professional development for Bradley pre-professionals. |
| 3.3 | Provide opportunities for teachers from Bradley PDS sites to lead, co-lead, or coordinate classroom, grade/team, or school wide projects in partnership with Bradley. |
| 3.4 | Provide short-term and ongoing professional development opportunities for Bradley PDS teachers, including action research and other topics requested by teachers at Bradley PDS sites. |
| 3.5 | Provide short-term and ongoing professional development opportunities for Bradley EHS faculty. |

Goal 4: Promote best practices in teaching, learning, and leadership through professional development, action research, and scholarship.

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| 4.1 | Encourage and support action research and scholarly research at Bradley PDS sites. |
| 4.2 | Support Bradley pre-professional and Bradley PDS teacher attendance/presentation at statewide conferences that feature effective teaching and learning practices. |
| 4.3 | Support Bradley EHS faculty attendance and presentation at the National PDS Annual Conference, and other conferences that feature school-university partnerships. |
| 4.4 | Disseminate research and information about Bradley PDS Partnership initiatives through publication on the Bradley PDS website, the <i>Bradley PDS Partnership Post</i> , and professional/scholarly journals. |

Goal 5: Support the health and well-being of students, their families, and the professionals who work with them.

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| 5.1 | Support the health and well-being of students, teachers, and families at Bradley PDS sites through innovative course connections, projects by Bradley student organizations, and special events. |
| 5.2 | Work with Bradley PDS teachers and principals to provide innovative health, recreation, and nutrition education and enrichment for students and their families. |
| 5.3 | Offer special training, recognition, and incentives to teachers at Bradley PDS sites for serving as cooperating teachers, participating in professional development, and leading/co-leading special projects. |
